Call for Abstracts for the PhD Session at the Summer SOC 2011

Based on the submitted thesis abstracts some of the PhD topics will be selected for presentation during the PhD Session as well as to prepare and present a poster during the poster session at the Summer SOC. Some of the candidates will be selected only for a poster presentation and the authors invited to the poster session only.
